Position Summary

The position assists with the oversight and spiritual formation of Community Groups, leaders and congregants at Redeemer Downtown and with operations related to the church's community life. The intern has responsibility for pastoral care and spiritual formation of assigned groups, assisting in the training of leaders, and ongoing multiplication of leaders and groups. The intern will also be responsible for supporting specific congregational ministry areas. The intern will also receive opportunities for professional development in pastoral care and formation and other areas of ministry.

- previous small group leadership experience
- aligned with the doctrinal orientation of Redeemer and embraces Redeemer's core values
