Requisites

- A growing/mature Christian, deeply rooted in the gospel of grace
- Growing in awareness and commitment to build cross-cultural gospel community
- Experienced in small group leadership
- Aligned with the doctrinal orientation of Redeemer and its core values

Position Summary

The Pastoral Intern role is a 20 hour per week part-time position focused on pastoral ministry through the Community Group system of Redeemer East Side. 50% of the role will involve care and equipping of CG Leaders and groups. The other 50% of the role is focused on spiritual formation projects that develop our church as missional disciples. Interns may also be called upon to teach workshops, write Bible discussion guides and assist Directors in other aspects of care and making missional disciples in the church.

Community Group Oversight

- Foster health and discipleship in 20+ Community Groups
 - Including 1:1 appointments with CG leaders, congegants/group participants and CG visits
 - Upkeep of CG information for assigned groups
- Contribute to Formation team by:
 - Monitoring eastsidecg@redeemer.com
 - Participating in pastoral care rotation (POC)
- Attend Formation Team meetings and staff meetings
- Attend and contribute to all Redeemer Community Group functions, including New Leader Basics and Cultivate, CG Leader trainings
- Meet with Director bi-weekly (minimum) for spiritual, theological, and practical coaching
- If asked, teach or assist with Redeemer-related classes or initiatives
- Build cross-cultural, welcoming culture at all Redeemer gatherings (including Sunday worship)
- Seek one-on-one appointments with congregants
- Complete other responsibilities as assigned by Community Group Directors or congregational pastoral leadership

Project Manager

- Lead the Formation team in running projects that spur on the spiritual formation of missional disciples
- Work with Community and Care Coordinator to expedite project flow
