

COMMUNITY GROUP INTERNSHIP JOB DESCRIPTION

Requisites

The ideal candidate is/has:

- a growing/mature Christian, deeply rooted in the gospel of grace
- previous small group leadership experience
- aligned with the doctrinal orientation of Redeemer and its core values (gospel-driven, city-focused, etc.)
- a member of Redeemer Presbyterian Church
- considering vocational ministry
- a future/current seminarian or grad
- a college degree
- proficiency in MS Office and Google Apps
- availability on weekends and evenings as needed (including availability to attend the Sunday services of the assigned congregation)

Descriptive

The position will entail the following responsibilities:

- work alongside one or more Community Group Directors to develop disciples/leaders in a group system
- assist with oversight of Community Groups and Beta Groups
- attend one Community Group Team planning meeting a month
- attend and contribute to all Redeemer-wide Community Group functions, including but not limited to New Leader Basics training, Cultivate Leader meetings
- meet with Community Group Director(s) bi-weekly (minimum) for spiritual, theological, and practical coaching
- if asked, teach or assist with Redeemer-related classes or initiatives
- complete administrative tasks to facilitate the health and growth of the Community Group system
- other responsibilities as assigned by Community Group Directors or pastoral leadership

Term & Compensation

The position will require 20 hours per week and pays \$25 per hour. A monthly unlimited MTA Metrocard will also be provided. The term of the position is from mid-June, 2018 through mid-July, 2019.
