SHORT DESCRIPTION

Evangelism and discipleship are foundational ministry fronts of a healthy missional church. The Evangelism & Discipleship Manager will work collaboratively with the CTC NYC team and external stakeholders to develop and deliver trainings, coaching and transferable tools for NYC pastors and evangelists. The Manager will work with churches to help activate their congregants for day to day missional living and engagement towards multiplying disciples in the diverse cultural and social contexts of NYC.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Research and Development

- Engage in ongoing research to understand the various contexts, challenges, needs, and best practices with respect to evangelism, discipleship, and missional engagement in the city.
- Develop a robust evangelism/discipleship curriculum that runs across all of the NYC training programs. This curriculum should build upon CTC's existing resources by integrating findings surfaced through the ongoing research described above.
- Lead the development of training modules and resources to equip pastors, church planters and evangelists for contextually appropriate evangelistic preaching
- Lead the development of resources to help pastors, church planters and evangelists foster a missional culture in their churches by equipping church members towards multiplying disciples.
- Provide direct coaching for pastors and church planters desiring to grow in evangelism and discipleship, and equip other CTC staff and coaches to do the same
- Deliver broader trainings to the body of Christ at large that will help develop the mental and practical frameworks for discipleship multiplication.
- Continually evaluate the effectiveness of the training, coaching, and resources developed, and refine as necessary

Networking and Partnerships

- Broadly network with churches and specialized evangelistic/discipleship ministries to share knowledge, promote collaboration, and make capacity-building resources available to churches and church plants.
- Develop strategic partnerships with specialty evangelistic/discipleship ministries that have expertise in serving group specific demographics (e.g. Muslims, Jewish communities, youth, etc.) towards helping churches increase their effectiveness in witnessing to these communities.
