 - In the Bible, we can read about a person named Daniel. Daniel loved God. God gave him wisdom and understanding, and he helped others using those gifts.
 Daniel had a special job working for the king.
 - One day, the king made a rule that if prayed to God, they would be thrown into the lion's den! But Daniel prayed anyway. The Bible says, "He got down on his knees three times a day and prayed and gave thanks before his God..."
 - So, Daniel was thrown into the lion's den! But don't be afraid. God heard Daniel's prayers!
 - The next day, the king went to the lion's den. And guess what? He saw the lions did not hurt Daniel- not one scratch!
 - Daniel said, "My God sent his angel and shut the lions' mouths, and they have not harmed me..."
 - The king saw that God saved Daniel. He wanted to worship God, too!
 - God rescued Daniel from the lions, and he sent his Son, Jesus, to rescue us from our sins!

Supplemental materials

- Lion Puppet Craft
 - Materials: Crayons, brown paper bag, tape or glue, scissors, tissue paper, <u>face</u> <u>pattern</u>, <u>mane pattern</u>, <u>arms/legs pattern</u>
 - Color the patterns and glue the head to the mane. Stuff the paper bag with tissue paper tape it shut. Glue the head, arms, and legs to the bag.
- Paper Plate Lion's Mane
 - Materials: Paper plate, colored paper, scissors, tape
 - Cut the center from the paper plate. Cut strips of colored paper and tape them to the paper plate ring.
