Lesson

- [Here](#) is the link to today’s lesson. We are learning about Jesus feeding the 5,000. After watching, consider these reflective questions:
 - What problem did the disciples bring to Jesus’ attention? (It was getting late, and the large crowd of people would need food.)
 - Jesus used a boy’s food to feed five thousand men, along with many women and children. What was the food? (The boy had five loaves of bread and two small fish.)
 - What did Jesus do before he gave the food to the people? (He gave thanks to his Father, God.)
 - Who gave Jesus the power to provide for the people? (God!) Does God care for our needs? (Yes!)
