Position Summary

The West Side Youth Associate will assist the West Side Youth Director in developing Redeemer West Side's Youth Ministry by undertaking key administrative and ministerial responsibilities, including, but not limited to, providing gospel-centered teaching primarily to the middle school youth, leading small and large group sessions, and coordinating virtual and in-person events.

West Side Youth is focused on sharing Christ's transforming message with students through intentional discipleship and community, while supporting parents in maturing their children's faith. The goal is to equip students to experience a gospel-focused adulthood, prepared for their future joys and challenges.

Job Description

Responsibilities

- Coordinate, prepare, implement theologically sound, culturally relevant, high energy, weekly, middle school sessions (games, worship, teaching, and discussion groups)
- Plan, coordinate, and lead youth events
- Provide administrative support to the Youth Ministry Director including database maintenance, weekly correspondence to youth, families, and volunteers, West Side Youth Calendar updates, and overseeing social media accounts
- Collaborate with Youth Ministry Director in building Youth Ministry
- Attend weekly youth staff meetings and provide weekly updates to Youth Ministry Director
- Recruit and engage with volunteers
- Develop relationships with individual youth and their families
- Participate in regular West Side staff meetings, trainings, and events
- Regular attendance and involvement in the life of Redeemer West Side
- Timely communication on internal platforms (Slack, Asana, Tallie, etc.)
